Professor Keiko Nakamura has worked on research in health and environment in urban areas with particular focus on: urban environment and health; population ageing; health promotion; determinants of health; healthy cities and urban policy; use of information technology in health services; community-based care for the elderly; healthcare workforce migration; public health emergencies; planetary health; cooperation for health development; and implementation science.

Prof. Nakamura is in charge of Tokyo Medical and Dental University's Data Science Global Leader Program, where young professionals from universities, ministries, city governments, and other institutions in various countries to become leading professionals in global health policy and community health.

Prof. Nakamura has also worked with the WHO Healthy Cities Programs since the early 1990's. She is strongly committed to the Alliance for Healthy Cities, an international network of healthy cities working closely with WHO in efforts to improve health in urban areas and reduce urban vulnerabilities in Asia, the Middle East, Africa, and the Pacific, through good governance and evidence-based urban design and policies.
